

Final Instructions – Day Visitors

Dear Parents / Guardians,

Please make yourself aware of the following:

- Rainbows, Beavers, Brownies & Leaders must arrive in uniform (Beavers & leaders wearing their camp badge) **You won't be able to get on site without them.**
- Day visitors will need to bring the following with them:
 - Wellies, waterproofs, change of clothes, hat, plus a **plastic bag** with their name on to take home all the craft bits that they will make on the day.
- Parents/guardians dropping off their child are only allowed to drop and run, **no parking** due to the number of cars we are expecting.
- Please share transport. Can we ask everyone to operate our one-way system **FROM & To** Maidenhead, please see map & follow our instructions below. You will not be allowed to cross the traffic to get into the site
- On arrival, Day Visitors please go straight to your sub-camp colour.
- Please be aware of the following arrival and departure times.

Brownies and Rainbows' arrivals:

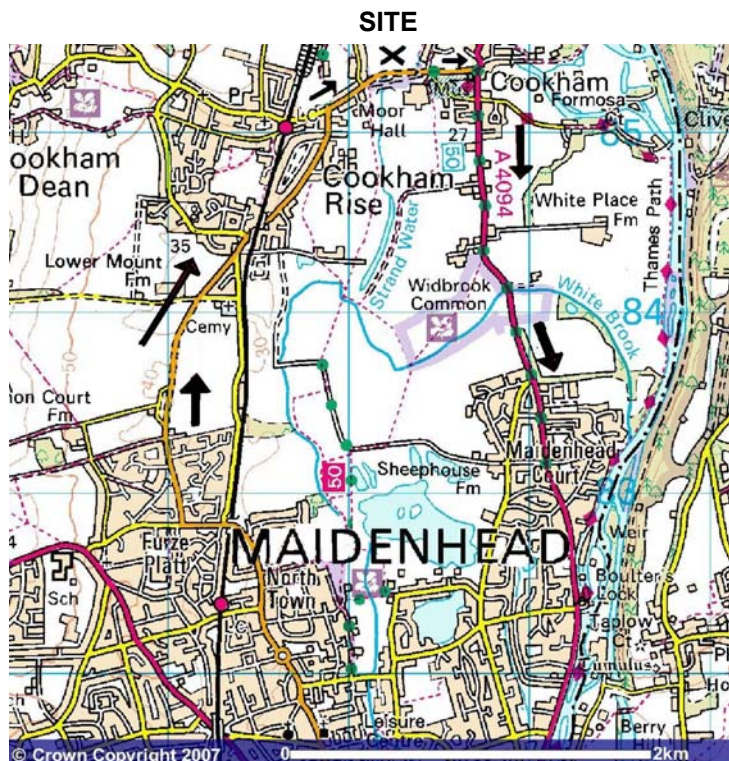
9.00am – Yellow

One Way System

To help us keep the traffic moving in Cookham, and make your drop off and collection easier, can we ask all parents to operate a one-way system when dropping off and picking up.

Please drive to the site from Maidenhead along *Switchback Road* under Railway bridge, along *Maidenhead Road*, turn right down *The Pound*, then turn left into National trust Car Park, into Site

Leave Site TURN LEFT, through Cookham village, right along *Sutton Road* then *Lower Cookham Road* back to Maidenhead.

Thank you for operating this one-way system, we are expecting over 1,000 people, over the weekend and we need to keep the local traffic moving.
